- **First Reconciliation and First Communion Preparation:** for children entering grades 2-4 who attend Catholic school only. Public school students are automatically enrolled in Sacramental Preparation when registering for Faith Formation. - **High School Faith Formation:** for public school students entering grades 9-10.
